In order to expand its mission, exhibits, and programs, the relocation of the 9/11 Tribute Center and Museum is a re-envisioned testament that honors the events and memories of September 11. What began as a grass-roots effort by the September 11th Families Association, a not-for-profit corporation comprised of victims' families, the creation of the new museum and workspace affords a prominent and meaningful space for exhibits, tours, and programs. LHSA+DP and Huntsman partnered to design and transform an ordinary commercial building into an inspirational museum and workplace to support the museum's mission. The major architectural and interior renewal to the existing commercial building included the insertion of new vertical transportation - a stairway and elevator - to connect three floors. Huntsman was also responsible for the planning and design of the museum's new offices and training facility, attached to the new museum.
